

«DRAWER STORAGE WALL» WIZARD

Start



- Select design M255 (T 27E) or M251 (T 36E)
- Select shelf base area $W \times D$ and shelf height H
- Select colour

! For regulatory and safety reasons, drawer shelves must be assembled from at least these elements.

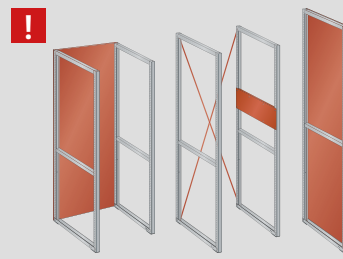
Side frames with accessories



- Select side frame **1**
- Floor anchoring, drawer shelves must be anchored.
- For installing drawers with a single or double safety catch, a locking profile is necessary.
- Select the appropriate side frame for using vertical pull-outs **2**.
- Optional: frame top covering, intermediate fill-in strip, levelling plates, etc.

Stabilising elements and walls



- Select stabilising elements: diagonal brace **3** or back panel **4**
- When back panels are not used, diagonal braces are absolutely necessary. Please note planning information.
- Optional: side panel covers. Partition walls, shelf side panels **5** to **7**

Universal and adjustable shelves with accessories



- Select universal shelves **8** and adjustable shelves **9**
- 2 universal shelves should be used for shelf heights up to 2 m. 3 universal shelves should be used for heights of 2.2–3.0 m.
- When using locked and fixed shelves, the universal shelves are dispensed with and serve as top shelves.
- Optional: dividers, folding fronts **10** shelf front cover strips **11**

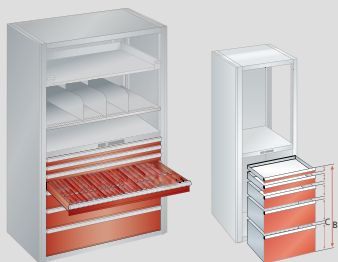
Shelves for drawer inserts



- Select locking and fixed shelves **12**
- Fixed and locking shelves incl. lock are used when drawers should be lockable.
- Determine the type of lock KEY, CODE, RFID or AUTO Lock and the height of the lock.

Drawers



- Select drawer **13**
- Determine front height, load capacity and drawer safety catch
- In the case of locked drawers, the clear height of the lock is decisive for locking and fixed shelves, i.e. the sum total of the drawer front heights (C) must correspond to the clear height (B)
- For appropriate partition material, see section «Partition materials & labelling system»

Pull-out shelves and heavy-duty pull-out shelves



- Select pull-out shelves **14** and heavy-duty pull-out shelves **15**
- Multiplex supports and slat inserts for heavy-duty pull-out shelves
- Optional: pull-out shelves with eyelets

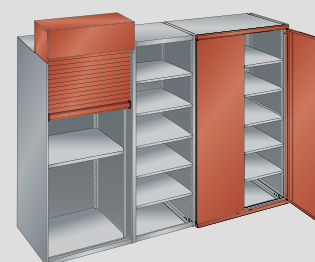
Vertical pull-outs with accessories



- Select vertical pull-out drawers **16**
- Vertical pull-outs in partial and total height and different front widths
- For the use of vertical pull-outs, the appropriate side frames must be selected, **2** incl. lock, top, base and intermediate shelves.
- Strictly follow planning information concerning installation widths of the vertical pull-outs.
- Optional: adjustable shelves, keyholes, storage shelves and locking brackets

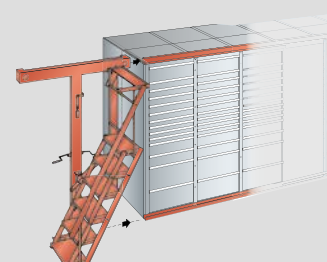
Protruding parts



- Select protruding parts: hinged doors, sliding doors, roller shutters **17** to **19**
- Strictly follow planning information concerning protruding part variants.
- Roller shutters always include a top shelf
- Hinged door and sliding door cover can be used both left as well as right in conjunction with side panel covers.

Safety ladders



- Select safety ladders **20**
- Up to 3 m bearing height for servicing drawers
- Ladder can be folded and is accessible on the left as well as the right
